- Do you have any questions from the lesson today?







Kids are often told to "be good," or "obey." Usually adults are telling them good things to do, things that will keep them safe or make life better. Part of growing up is learning to do the right thing without being asked, and even if you won't be rewarded for doing it or disciplined if you don't. Doing what is right without being asked is what character is all about. Try this month to do something good without anyone telling you to. That is character!

Think about It

What does the Bible mean when it talks about character? It's not referring to a "character" in a story, but rather it's referring to the kind of person you are. Perhaps you have heard it said, "Character is who you are when no one is watching." Another way to say it would be, "Character is the real you." When people are around, we often try to be a better person. That doesn't mean we are faking; it just means we have an incentive to be better because people are watching. We might be kinder, more helpful, or watch our words more carefully. But God is interested in who we are when no one is watching. After all, He's watching all the time and He knows our heart. God rewards us according to our heart, not by how good we look when people are watching. How are you when no one is watching? How's your character?

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The family challenge!

Are you up for the challenge? Determine as a family what the reward will be if you complete the challenge!

YOUR CHALLENGE: Part of character is doing the right thing and getting no credit for it: doing it without telling anyone. When God sees, but no one else does, then we know we are doing it for the right reason. As a family, think of a Top-Secret Mission you can do. What could you do for someone, or another family, to help them or serve them, but without them ever finding out who did it? That way only God knows what you did, and they just get the blessing and can only thank God for it. That is your mission should you choose to accept it. I Double Dare Ya!

Name of the Game: What's Missing? Needed: Miscellaneous objects from the house

How to Play: Pick twenty varied household objects and display them in the center of the table. Everyone should take one to two minutes to study the objects.
