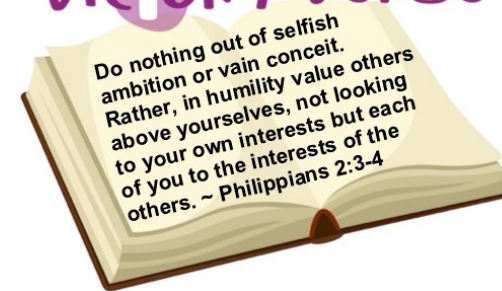
Double DaRE ya!
